SUCCESS MEASURES



Double the 6-year transfer baccalaureate graduation rate.



Raise the SUNY-to-SUNY transfer-out rate to 60%.



Reduce transfer credit loss, excess credit, and time to degree.

OPERATIONAL GOALS



Establish regional and statewide campus transfer partnerships.



Obtain SUNY-to-SUNY equivalencies.



Establish course acceptance rates and improve access to student-level data.

TRANSFER ADVISORY COUNCIL

The Transfer Advisory Council (TAC) collaborates with the Office of Transfer and Articulation to improve transfer experiences, credit transferability, and academic alignment. It also works to improve campus communication, information sharing, and stakeholder engagement in support of transfer improvement. The Council convenes subgroups which will recommend and help establish priorities for SUNY Transfer Paths, student services and data and communication strategies and systems.

Office of Transfer and Articulation

The Office of Transfer and Articulation (OTA) coordinates advisory groups, transfer services and policies and provides support to all SUNY campuses.



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
