Transfer Task Force Report

- The Transfer Task Force put forward a set of comprehensive recommendations designed to dramatically improve the SUNY transfer landscape and outcomes of transfer students, particularly those transferring from community to baccalaureate-granting campuses
- SUNY is embarking on a multi-year initiative to implement the task force recommendations that will involve all stakeholders at the campus and System level
- Key to realizing significant change, will be a steady focus on addressing transfer issues and improving transfer student outcomes among all SUNY stakeholders

- Focused on supporting students and providing resources, support and training for faculty and staff



 Transformation Project (DTP) work




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Systemwide Advisory Groups

- Student Advisory Committee
- Standing, consultative bodies made up of leaders, faculty and staff from all SUNY sectors
- Will engage regularly with SUNY OTA to advance recommendations with common understanding and support successful implementation

SUNY Office of Transfer and Articulation (OTA)

- Works collaboratively with advisory groups
- Assists in setting, monitoring and reporting on campus and system improvement goals
- Develops, publishes and maintains transfer data sets and tools, and supports data governance
- Provides direct support to students, faculty and staff for systemmanaged transfer processes and policies
- Serves as the SUNY-wide lead for transfer-related technologies





How Will We Measure Success?

Success Metrics

- 1. Double the overall 6-year transfer graduation rate for the 2025 cohort
- 2. Raise the SUNY-to-SUNY transfer-out rate
- 3. Reduce the number of transfer credits that are not accepted
- 4. Reduce the average amount of excess credit
- 5. Reduce the average time to degree by ½ semester

Operational Goals

- Provide universal access to SUNY-to-SUNY transfer equivalency data
- 2. Provide transfer advisor training for all campuses
- 3. Establish cross-campus partnerships between 4-year and community colleges
- 4. Obtain and publish transfer credit acceptance rates for all campuses
- 5. Ensure general education and Transfer Path courses are appropriately articulated



Recruit and provide an initial orientation to transfer liaisons.

Begin setting specific goals and targets with campuses.
